

FREE LEGAL HELP FILING FOR **DACA RENEWAL**

If you are a DACA recipient there is important information you need to know about filing for renewal:

- If your DACA benefits are expiring between **September 5, 2017** and **March 5, 2018**, you need to file an application for renewal before **October 5, 2017**.
- Renewal applications received by USCIS after October 5, 2017 will not be considered.

John Jay is committed to supporting all DACA students in the renewal process, and is partnering with trusted legal services organizations to provide **free legal support to students**, and reminds students to beware of scams. All John Jay students are eligible to apply for a **DACA Renewal Scholarship** to cover the cost of their filing fee.

➤ **Free DACA Renewal Clinic SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 16, 2017 (9 am – 1pm)**

- **WHO:** Any John Jay student eligible to file for DACA renewal is invited to come and receive free legal assistance
- **WHERE:** The clinic will be held at **Northern Manhattan Coalition for Immigrant Rights (NMCIR)**, 5030 Broadway, #639, which is right off the 215th Street 1 train stop.
 - FREE ROUNDTRIP METROCARDS will be provided to the first 40 students who make an appointment for Saturday's clinic (see below how to sign up).
- **WHEN:** Saturday, September 16, 2017 from 9 am to 1 pm.
 - If you cannot make the clinic on Saturday, you can also sign up for an appointment with NCMIR at another time (see below how to sign up).
- **HOW TO SIGN UP:** Email **NANCY YANG (nyang@jjay.cuny.edu)** as soon as possible but no later than **Friday, 9/15**. In your message, be sure to include:
 - your name,
 - email address, and
 - phone number
- **WHAT'S NEXT?** By attending the clinic you will receive:
 - Help filling out your DACA renewal application;
 - Help submitting an application for the DACA Renewal Scholarship to cover your renewal fee (\$495 sent directly to USCIS);
 - Help sending the entire file to USCIS (postage paid); and
 - Help following up with USCIS if needed while your application is being processed
- **WHAT YOU SHOULD BRING:**
 - **For DACA Renewal (I-765 & I-821D) bring:**
 - Social Security Card;
 - (if applicable) Deportation order or criminal disposition dated after your first application;
 - 2 passport style photos;
 - If you filed your first application elsewhere, please bring it/all materials you used to file with you; and
 - Cost for immigration money order \$495 (unless you're applying for the DACA Renewal scholarship (see below))
 - **For DACA Renewal Scholarship (\$495 sent directly to USCIS) - ANY John Jay student (NOT limited to Hispanic students) is eligible to apply, deadline 9/16/17- bring:**
 - Complete the [Scholarship Application](#);
 - 500-700 word essay (see application for details); and
 - evidence of financial need (see application for details).
