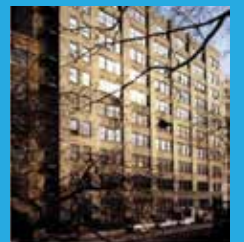

Today John Jay College of Criminal Justice stands at the threshold of a new chapter in our remarkable story. Founded in 1964 as a college to educate police officers in sciences and liberal arts, John Jay has transformed into the preeminent national and international leader in educating for justice –a broadly envisioned educational experience embracing social, economic, political, and criminal justice.

Designed by Skidmore, Owings & Merrill, one of the top firms in the nation, the building is a stunning work of architecture that can proudly take its place among the great buildings of New York City.

This 620,000-square-foot building, 13-story vertical campus houses 56 state-of-the-art classrooms, new cyber lounges, computer labs, cutting edge science facilities, Emergency Management and High Rise Simulator labs, a moot court, conference rooms, the Anya and Andrew Shiva Gallery, a black box theater, the Lynn and Jules Kroll Atrium, great dining facilities and many other educational and administrative features in a 100 percent wireless environment.

The Jay Walk, cleverly named by our students, provides a remarkable outdoor rooftop commons where all members of the John Jay community can come together. Anchoring Haaren Hall to the new building and rising five stories above street level, this 60,000-square-foot park-like area features lawn space, trees and benches. We are also deeply honored that a World Trade Center Memorial sculpture was installed on this campus, one that commemorates the loss of over 60 members of our community on September 11, 2001.

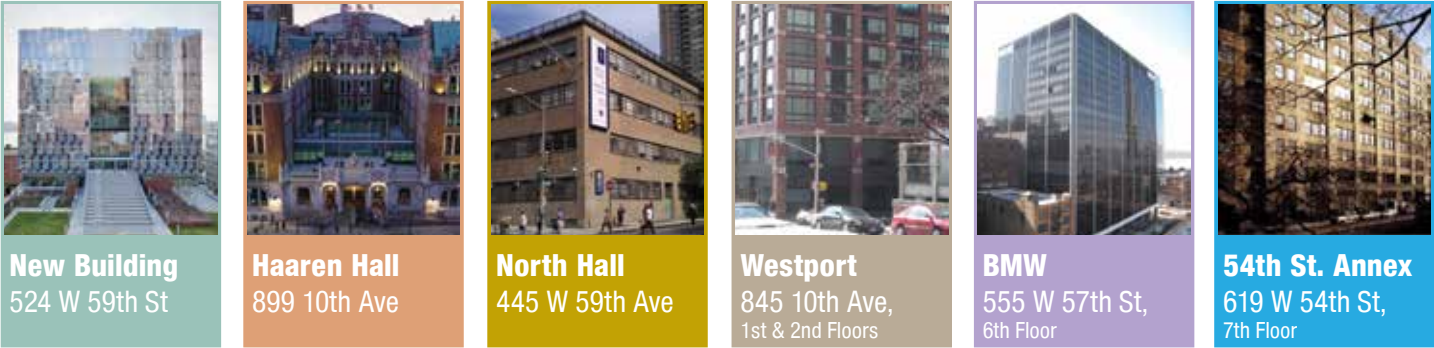
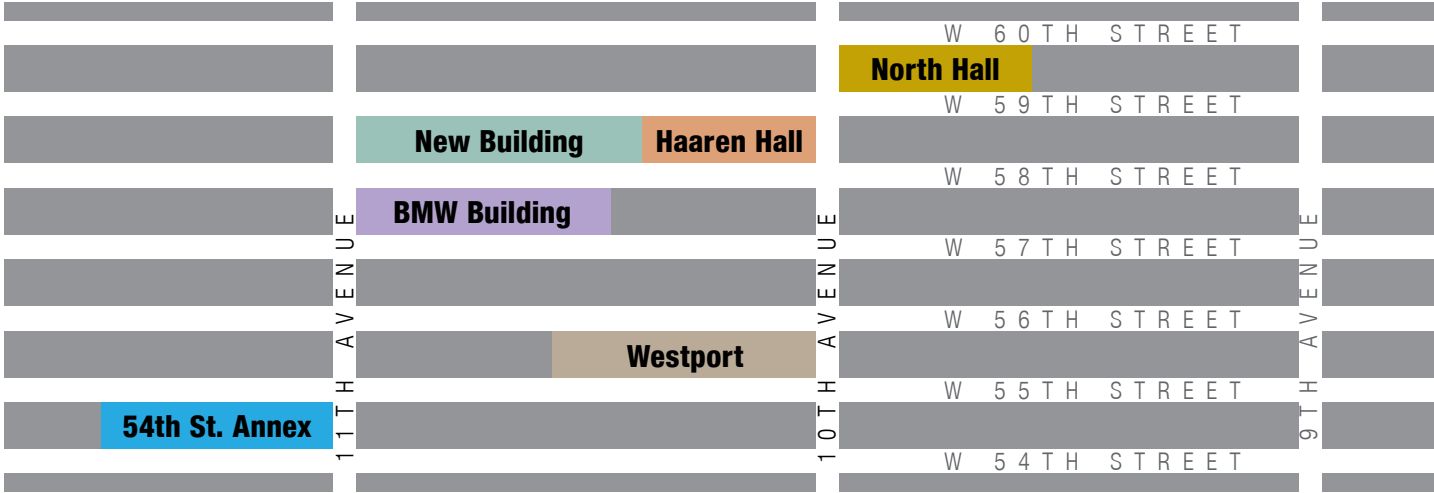

All have a direct connection to the Public Safety desks. Restrooms are equipped with panic buttons and/or emergency phones which connect with the Public Safety desks without dialing.

NO SMOKING

John Jay College is a No Smoking Facility. There is no smoking permitted within 25 feet of all entrances. There is no smoking on the New Building Jay Walk outdoor plaza or terraces at the Westport facility.

FIRE EXITS

Fire Exit Information is displayed on maps on the wall nearest to the entrance in all classrooms.

ID AND TURNSTILE SYSTEM

A valid ID is required for access to the College. The College has an integrated access control system therefore the same ID card can be used in every campus building.

Visitors to the College or persons who have lost or forgotten their ID card must present a form of photo identification. After stating their business at the College they are required to sign in. This also includes guests accompanied by members of the College community. Visitors will be announced to the person they are visiting where appropriate. Visitors from any other CUNY College must show their ID card and the sign in procedures are waived. All members of the College community are encouraged to submit the names of expected guests to the Department of Public Safety ahead of the visit in order to expedite the individual's admission to the college.

DEPARTMENT RELOCATION NEWS & SCHEDULE

Although the move to the New Building is complete, the College continues to undergo office relocations and space re-organizations as a result of a major Haaren Hall renovation project which involves extensive renovation of the 3rd, 4th, 5th, and 6th floor wings plus total heating, ventilation, and cooling system equipment replacement. Many academic and administrative departments and offices have been temporarily moved to North Hall for the duration of the renovation. The project is expected to be completed in Fall 2014 at which time the relocated departments will move back to their Haaren Hall areas. 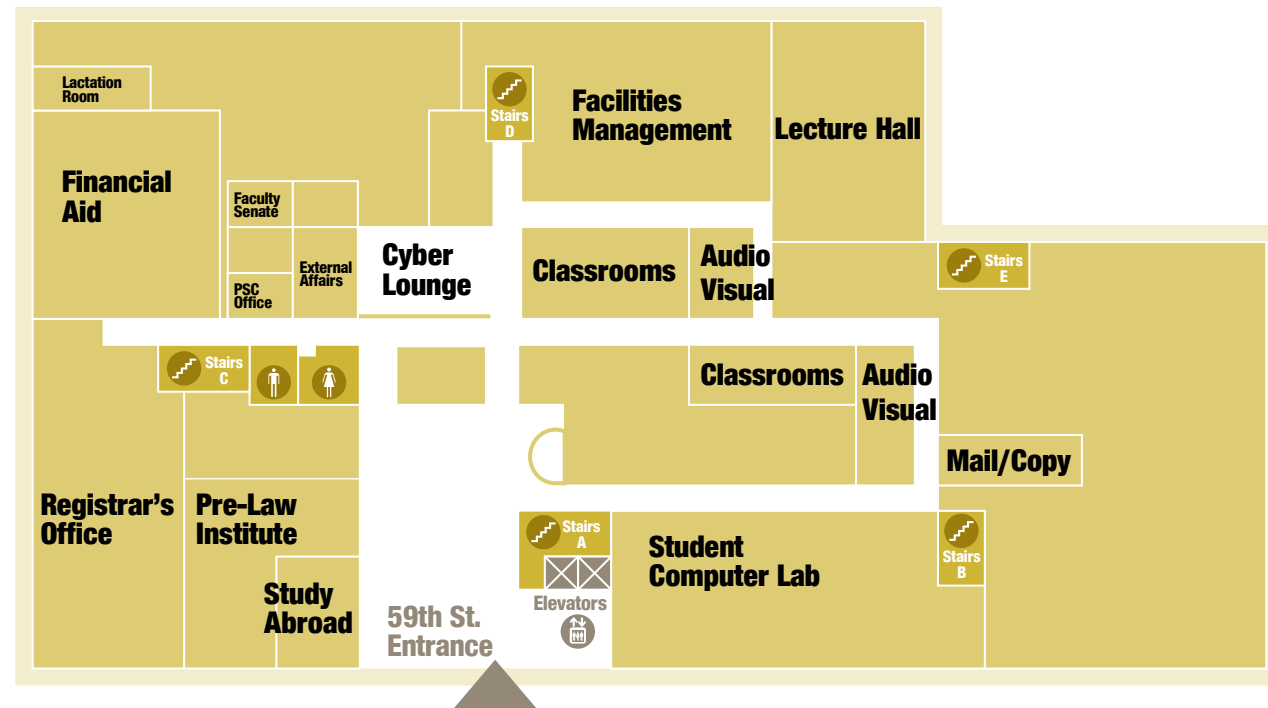


DID YOU KNOW?
